

# JARRAHDAL PRE-FEDERATION WALK TRAIL

Trail starts at the Old Post Office Museum, where parking is available

1. **OLD POST OFFICE**  
Opened as a post and telegraph office in 1895.
2. **1872 MILL SITE**  
Location of the original Jarrahdale Timber Mill.
3. **SITE OF MILLAR'S COTTAGE**  
A fine building used to entertain timber company visitors and directors
4. **MURRAY ARMS HOTEL**  
First licensed in 1886. Now known as the Jarrahdale Tavern.
5. **ANGLICAN CHURCH OF ST. PAUL**  
Built in 1896 and former Good Templars' Lodge.
6. **ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH**  
Blessed and opened by the Reverend Duff in 1885. Present Church built in the 1950s.
7. **CEMETERY**  
Established 1872 and represents a lasting reminder of Jarrahdale's past.
8. **SITE OF OLD TOWN WORKERS' HOUSES**  
Known as Crock's Cottages because Harry Crock built and leased them.
9. **SITE OF METHODIST CHURCH**  
Wesleyan. Built in the 1890s
10. **SITE OF MANSE**  
House of the Methodist Minister.
11. **BRIDGE OVER GOORALONG BROOK**  
Built c 1902.
12. **OLD RAILWAY FORMATION**  
Original Jarrahdale to Rockingham Tramway, built 1872, with Centenary Log (1972).
